St. Ann's Parish and Its Missions Wedding Information Form 2 To be given to Couple

1. Weddings are normally at 11:00 PM or 1:00 PM on Saturdays. The priest must approve any other times. Please arrange date at office. Cost for a wedding are as following:
Registered parishioner \$275.00 plus a donation to the priest. (Minimum \$100.00 payable to the priest)
Non-parishioners \$ 350.00 plus a donation to the priest. (Minimum \$100.00 payable to the priest)
2. The couple are required to meet Priest, at least four months before wedding, fill pre-nuptial forms, then attend an Engaged Encounter weekend at their own cost [\$200.00], and then have one final meeting with Priest before Wedding Day.
3. On the day of the Wedding Service, photographs can take place before the Liturgy or afterwards, as long as, everything is completed and the Church is left clean. Owing to the small size of the Churches, we ask that everyone keep talking to a minimum inside the building. SILENCE is required to encourage an atmosphere of Prayer, Reverence and Awe.
4. We do not permit the use of flash photography during the Liturgy of the Word [the readings] or the Eucharist; this must be strictly adhered to.
5. We do not permit the use of confetti or any thing else that may cause a mess inside or outside of the Church.
6. The Wedding Rehearsal usually takes place on Friday at 6:00 PM.
7. If a visiting priest will conduct the wedding, proof of marriage preparation must be given to the office two months before the wedding, along with all other documents – birth certificates, communion and/or confirmation certificates.
8. Any priest outside the Diocese of Tucson must be pre-approved by the Bishop. A letter of introduction and statement of good standing from the visiting priests' Diocese must be sent to use at least 2 months before the wedding so it can be sent on to the Diocese of Tucson for approval. Cost of church \$275. 00. Visiting priest to be paid directly by wedding party.
9. Priests outside St. Ann's Parish, even if they are priests of the Diocese of Tucson, must have the approval of the Pastor to perform a wedding. Without approval, the wedding will not be valid.
