Gary Leidich
Retired Executive VP First Energy

As a retired utility executive, Gary's career spanned more than 45 years in the electric industry. Lastly, he was Executive Vice President for First Energy, where, as President of FirstEnergy Generation, his responsibilities included all generation facilities, 26,000Mw in six states, including nuclear, fossil, hydro, and renewable units.

Mr. Leidich is an IEEE Senior member, teaches a senior and graduate level course at the University of Toledo, and currently serves on the board of the Western Electricity Coordinating Council (WECC), where he was also Chair. He is also past Chair of the University of Toledo Foundation, a University of Toledo COE Alumni for both his Bachelors and Masters degrees, as well as a Distinguished Alumni Award recipient. Gary is also an instructor in the leadership program at the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations, the Executive Reactor Technology program at MIT, and does consulting for electric utility industry.
