## Cruise Route K 271

**Jun. 14 Sat.** You will be transferred from Dubrovnik airport to the port, where embarkation begins at 14:00h. Get settled in your cabin before going on a walking tour of Dubrovnik around 17:00h, the “Pearl of Adriatic”. Walk through Stadum – both a street and a square, the most famous place inside the town walls, enlisted as UNESCO’s World Heritage site, where your guide will show you the most interesting sights of Dubrovnik and visit the Franciscan Monastery with its Pharmacy. After returning to ship enjoy a Welcome reception followed by dinner. (D)

**Jun. 15 Sun.** Breakfast. Early in the morning enjoy the magic scenery as the ship cruises around Dubrovnik city walls to continue to one of the Elaphiti islands for a swim stop. Afternoon arrival in Slano, a peaceful fishermen’s village and our starting point to Ston, situated on Peljesac peninsula and once fortified small village famous for its oysters. Peljesac peninsula is known as one of the best wine producing regions in Croatia. After exploring the town, we leave to a small nearby village to enjoy the authentic local oyster tasting. Captain’s dinner in Slano. (B L D)

**Jun. 16 Mon.** Breakfast. This morning, we sail to the Island of Mljet. Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Continue our cruise towards the Korčula island, best known as a birthplace of Marco Polo. Afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of this enchanting town surrounded by walls, which is one of the best-preserved medieval cities in the Mediterranean. Overnight in Korčula where you can enjoy a gourmet experience at the multiple restaurants. (B L)

**Jun. 17 Tue.** Breakfast. This morning, we sail to Lastovo. Enjoy a swim during your morning cruise. Continue sailing through lunch. Upon arrival in Lastovo. Lastovo, is an island known for its Venetian architecture from the 15th and 16<sup>th</sup> centuries. It is the most forested Croatian island with more than 70% of the island is forest. In 2006 Lastovo was declared a Nature Park. Overnight in Lastovo. Overnight Lastovo. (B L)

**Jun 18 Wed.** Breakfast. This morning sail towards island of Hvar. Hvar the longest and sunniest island in the Adriatic. A swim stop is planned before lunch. Upon arrival in Hvar join a guided tour of the town of Hvar you will see many historical sights. St Stephen’s Square and Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above Hvar Town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over the bay and Pakleni islands. Overnight in Hvar or Stari Grad. (B L)

**Jun. 18 Thu.** Breakfast. Morning, we sail to small island Biševo to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. Possibility of visit will depend on weather conditions; however, you will be notified in the morning after breakfast. Cruise to my favorite island Vis. During Tito Times it was a strategic naval Yugoslav base and restricted to the public. Due to this isolation, Vis has a special charm – “the Mediterranean as it once was” making it interesting to visit. Since the independence of Croatia, the island began opening slowly to the outside world. Some of Europe’s largest and great naval battles had happened in the waters of Vis. Vis Island holds many historic secrets and we will explore Vis history by military Land Rover Defenders. Overnight in the port of Vis. (B L).

**Jun 19 Fri.** Breakfast. This morning, we sail to Split. Enjoy a swim stop along our journey. After lunch we arrive at Split. Upon arriving in Split, join a guided tour of the city. Visit the seaside promenade, tour the Roman Emperor Diocletian’s Palace built in approximately 300 BC. Continue to the historical center of the city is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Your evening is at leisure to explore Split and possibly dine in one of several outdoor cafes. (B L)

**Jun. 20 Sat.** Breakfast. Disembark for transfers to Split airport.
