- Tides Inn Unrestricted Funds: Would request that the Council discusses with the public what their plan is for the \$60,000 in unrestricted funds from the Tides Inn as unrestricted funds are rare.
- Election Code: The Election Code is either no longer on the website or not easily found. She requests that it get put back up along with the Tlingit & Haida Election Code that is linked to ours. She liked that KFSK mentioned that PIA had 30 days to fill the seats that are vacant and if the Council as a whole cannot, then the President would appoint someone. There are a lot of really good people in the community and she hopes that they will be able to apply for the vacant seats and a public notice goes out.
- Transition of Council: she thanked those who are leaving Council and welcomed those who are now on Council. She would like to see the welcoming and thanking of these Council Members better than it has been done.
- PIA Enterprises (Ent.): As of today, she is resigning from the PIA Ent. Chair seat. She is and continues to be very excited about PIA Ent. Brandon Ware was given the PIA Ent. binder with all of the information. At the last meeting in January, all minutes were approved, which are now with Jalyn. She requests that PIA Ent. meetings are posted on the PIA website. She has notified Holly that she is resigning. She would like to see the management decisions for PIA Ent. go back to being separate from the Council that changes every year. She disagrees that management decisions were made without notification or input from the Board. She will continue to be available for any wrap up with the PIA Ent. Board.
