PURPOSE

The purpose of this program is to provide those in need with basic items that are not covered by other services [Examples: diapers, formula, personal hygiene products, diapers, soaps and cleaning supplies].

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be Alaska Native/American Indian
- Must be enrolled at the Petersburg Indian Association
- Must have limited resources
- Must be 18 years of age or older

DAYS AND TIMES OF DISTRIBUTION

Items will be available for pickup or delivery on Wednesdays. Please arrange your pickup or delivery with PIA staff.

DEADLINES FOR SERVICE

Forms [shopping list and initial intake form] must be submitted by Tuesday at 1pm, the day before the Wednesday distribution.

FREQUENCY OF USE

Use of this service is limited to one trip per month per household.

VALUE PER HOUSEHOLD

Households with 1 member will receive \$20 worth of products. Households with 2+ members will receive \$25 worth of products. This program is intended to be supplementary, to allow your own budget to spread a little farther each month.

ELDERS AGES 60+ AND DISABLED PERSONS

We encourage those that are 60+ or disabled to take advantage of our Paratransit service by calling and scheduling a ride the day before your distribution. Please call 907-650-7788.
