Starting this fall on Thursday Nights at 7:30, Spring Hill lanes is creating the “**Tame the Beast**” **Sport shot league**. You will get to bowl on the same type of conditions the pros bowl on. It will be fun and a real eye opener for most of us. The League Meeting is on Sep 5 at 7:30. We will begin bowling on Sep 12 at 7:30. \$20 per week, 33 weeks, 3-person team, 3 games each. 9 point system with 90% of 220 Handicap.

## New USBC Rule this Year

**The Dry towel rule Effective August 1, 2019.** Any kind of dry towel, shammy or other types of towels may be used during play. **No liquids may be used** on the ball during play. If some foreign matter gets stuck on the ball that cannot be rubbed off by a dry towel, then the tournament manager or league officer can allow enough liquid to remove the foreign matter, the same as a damaged ball.
