New USBC Youth Membership Rule

Starting with the 2020-2021 Season, the maximum age for Youth membership is 18. USBC Youth membership is available to individuals who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to August 1.

New USBC Rule this Year

Static weight and balance holes.

- USBC has increased the static weight difference to 3 oz for all balls weighing over 10 pounds.
- On **Aug 1, 2020**, no balls will be allowed to have weight holes.
- All gripping holes on all balls must be used on every release. If a bowler only uses fingers and no thumb, the thumb hole must be plugged, and an “+” must be etched in the ball near the center of the palm and the hand must cover the + to be a legal release.
- Since house balls are not drilled for specific bowlers, they are exempt from the weight hole rule.
