Editor's Message - Hello Bowlers!

We all wish you a healthy and prosperous New Year. Let us pray that 2021 will be better than 2020 with a lot of strikes.

League memberships are down due to the Covid-19 virus. The good news is that the vaccine is on its way! Let's all stay healthy until we get our vaccine and this virus is beaten.

We have the 60th Annual Hernando County Women's Tournament scheduled for April 17th-18th, 2021. The 3rd Annual Hernando County USBCA Men's Tournament is scheduled for May 15th-16th and the 4th Annual Hernando County USBCA Open Tournament is scheduled for June 5th-6th. The tournaments will be split again this year with the team event at either one house and doubles and singles being bowled at the other house. Next year, we will be bowling the entire tournament at one house. For example, the Women's will be bowled in Strike City and the Men's will be bowled in Spring Hill Lanes. The following year, the Women's will be bowled in Strike City. We are also planning on adding a Senior tournament (over 50-64) with a separate division for Super Seniors (65 and Older).

Coaching Hint: There comes a time when you need to throw a strike or just get a good count for your first 150 game, 200 game, your first honor score or just to win a game for your team.

- 1. Never think DON'T, like don't miss right, don't throw it too hard, don't be nervous. Your body will only listen to every word after Don't.
- 2. Take a deep breath through your nose and let it out through your mouth. This helps to burn off adrenalin.
- 3. Focus on one positive thing like "watch the ball roll over your mark". You may not get a strike every time, but it will greatly improve your chances of success.

National USBC Updates

Start of 2021 USBC Open Championships in Las Vegas shifts to May 1

The start date of the 2021 USBC Open Championships will move to May 1, and the event will feature a modified schedule to allow for social distancing with one team per pair during competition.

The tournament is slated to run for 79 days from May 1-July 18, but adjustments to the daily squad schedule will allow the entry capacity to remain at more than 9,300 five-player teams. Based on demand, the 2021 Open Championships can be extended as far as July 31, increasing the potential capacity to nearly 11,000 teams.

The event originally was scheduled to begin March 6 and conclude July 18.

League Information Updates

Adding and losing teams during the season

One of the commonly asked questions of the Rules Team is: What do we do when a team wants to join or leave the league? A team withdrawing from or joining a league affects the schedule and the prize fund. The schedule must reflect the number of teams in the league. Don't let bowlers get behind in fees

Bowlers make a commitment to the league when they sign up, but now you have a bowler who has not paid his or her fees. If the bowler is present, ask the bowler to pay the fees prior to bowling. If the bowler does not pay, you may tell the bowler and team captain that the bowler cannot participate until paid. If all efforts to collect fees fail, the league may file a complaint with USBC following the procedures in Rule 115b. Use the following tools to assist in the process to file a complaint:

Don't forget... Rule 115b limits the number of league sessions a bowler may be charged to six. Please do not wait for six weeks to address bowlers who owe fees.

Do your bowlers know... what fees must be paid when absent? Please be sure your league members, especially new bowlers to the league, are aware what fees must be paid when they are absent.

The season-opening PWBA Kickoff Classic Series will give you a chance to see the best female bowlers in the world compete in four exciting tournaments, and you can tune in for countless hours of coverage for FREE!

The qualifying and match-play rounds for each event will only require a BowlTV login to view the action, so you can watch these rounds at no cost. You just have to create a login, if you don't already have one.

The stepladder finals at each tournament will require an annual (\$79.95), monthly (\$9.95) or event pass (\$4.95 for each event or \$12.95 for access to all four stepladders) to watch.

The 2021 PWBA season will begin Wednesday, Jan. 20 at 11 a.m. Eastern with the opening round of qualifying at the PWBA Bowlers Journal Classic, the first of the Kickoff's four events.

BowlTV will be covering every pair in play from the International Training and Research Center in Arlington, Texas, for all three national events (PWBA Bowlers Journal Classic, PWBA ITRC Classic and PWBA Hall of Fame Classic) and the regional competition (PWBA Arlington Regional).
