Call to Conclave

By virtue of the power and authority in me vested as Grand Commander of Iowa, I hereby declare that the One Hundred Sixty-First (161st) Annual Conclave of the Grand Commandery Knights Templar of Iowa, shall be held June 6, 2025 at the Holiday Inn and Bien Venu event center in Cedar Falls, IA.
