Town of Tomah Town Board Meeting

Those present: Breanne Zarembo, Teresa Hubert, Brian Hubert, Vaughn Kuehl, Don Kaus, Ernie Thackeray, Doug Bauman, Dick Baumgarten, John Ollendick, Al Bartels, Randie Johns, Kathy Flatoff, Howard Hanson, Todd Zarembo, Shannon Sparks, Pete Thorson, and Kevin Schmitz.

- The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman Hanson.
- The clerk's report was read. Randie Johns made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Al Bartels seconded the motion. Motion Carried
- The treasurer's report was read. Al Bartels made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Randie Johns seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Public Comment Period
 - Pete Thorson wanted to make sure the board knew about programs for bridge money available. Howard Hanson explained how we applied for funding for a bridge on Interior Rd, and that the Ho-Chunk Nation has accepted our application and will be paying for a portion of the Highland Ave bridge.
 - Todd Zarembo mentioned discoloration on the underside of the box culvert on Hobnail Ave. because the potholes have gotten very bad. He has pictures if the board would like to take a look.
 - Howard Hanson explained about the work being done by Brickl Bros. A new steel roof was put on the shop, and it was noted that the side walls were in very bad shape as well, so Brickl replaced 3 sides of the building. This will add \$18,000 to the project price.
 - New board members will take office on April 18, the same day as the annual meeting.
 - Howard Hanson thanked Randie Johns for 28 years of service, and Allan Bartels for 14 years of service to the Town.
- Open Seal Coat Bids
 - Fahrner Construction sent a bid, but did not follow the bid specs. For 1 mile single seal 20 foot wide with dark granite chips, cost would be \$35,611.50.
 - Scott Construction sent a bid with all requirements according to the bid specs. For 1 mile single seal 20 foot wide with blue granite chips would be \$29,853.00
 - Scott Construction also bid \$63,210.00 for a double seal over gravel, 20 ft wide for 1 mile.
 - Randie Johns made a motion to accept the bid from Scott Construction for blue granite chips for \$29,853.00/mile. Al Bartels seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.
- Motion was made by Al Bartels to adjourn the meeting. Randie Johns seconded the motion. Motion carried.
