Monthly Board Meeting

Those Present: Howard Hanson, Randie Johns, Allan Bartels, Teresa Hubert, Breanne Zaremba, and Vaughn Kuehl.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Hanson.

The clerk's report was read. Randie Johns made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried. Side Note: the Town received \$7,692.14 on October 2, 2020 for the Routes to Recovery Grant. The clerk will be submitting the final round of reimbursements this week.

The treasurer's report was read. Allan Bartels made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Approval of the 2021 Town Budget

No changes were made to the proposed budget. Randie Johns made a motion to approve the 2021 Town Budget in the amount of \$395,036. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Town Road Name Signs

A list of all road names was sent to the County. They will be reviewing the list and then placing an order. Signs will probably take 2-3 months to arrive.

Tomah Ambulance

Howard Hanson attended the City of Tomah Council Meeting last month. The Council changed the per capita rate from \$6.25 to \$5.00 per person, with an annual review. The change was made to the Town budget.

Braund Addition

In order to vacate a portion of Herb Rd, there will need to be a public hearing, with notices in 3 consecutive week's newspaper, and a resolution will need to be written. Gary Sime is working on the legal description for the piece of land. We will then need to get a deed written up.

New Business

Vaughn Kuehl would like to ask the Town to reimburse him for the charges that were charged from Gerke Excavating from the house fire he had in 2016. Because this was a bill charged by the Oakdale Area Fire Association, the Town paid the cost of the bill to the Oakdale Area Fire Association. The Town cannot reimburse him for that cost.

A motion was made by Randie Johns to adjourn the meeting. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.
