Speed Sign on Heritage Avenue

The Speed Sign that Monroe County placed on Heritage Ave lasted only about 18 hours, someone removed the post with the sign and threw it in a ditch. The Monroe County Sheriff's Dept. does not want to put it back up, it is not damaged functionally, but it has considerable cosmetic damage. The highest speed clocked was 61 mph. Average Speed was 33 mph. Kurt Marshaus would like to see the whole town posted at 45 mph. The feeling of the board is that speed is more noticeable because there is an increase in traffic. No action was taken.
