Town of Tomah Board Meeting

Those present: Howard Hanson, Randie Johns, Allan Bartels, Richard Baumgarten and Breanne Zaremba.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm by Chairman Hanson.

Then clerk's report was read. Al Bartels made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The treasurer's report was read. Randie Johns made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Al Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Review the Department of Revenue Equalization Report

The equalized value for the town went up by approximately \$824,000. There were 8 sales last year, 1 was for vacant land and the other 7 included houses.

Review & Act on the Monroe County Tentative Supervisory District Plan

The board reviewed the maps and breakdown of the 16 proposed new supervisory districts for Monroe County. Randie Johns made a motion to approve the Monroe County Tentative Supervisory District Plan. Al Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Review & Act on Government Accountability Board Accessibility Compliance Audit

During the Spring Election held in April 2014, inspectors from the GAB were sent out to audit polling places in Monroe County. The issues that the GAB found and how they will be remedied are as follows:

- There are no van-accessible parking spaces marked in the Town Hall parking lot
 - The town will create a temporary van-accessible parking space using traffic cones.
Breanne Zaremba will request a "van-accessible" sign from the GAB to post as well
- The accessible pathway has breaks or edges where the difference in height was over ½"
 - Howard will have the patrolmen fill in those places
- The threshold for the accessible entrance is more than ½" higher than the level of the sidewalk outside.
 - We will look into finding a moveable ramp that can be put in place for each election.

Wisconsin Towns Association Fall Workshop

The fall workshop will be held on September 24, 2014 in Tomah at the Cranberry Country Lodge. Howard Hanson is interested in attending; Randie Johns is going to check his schedule to see if he can attend. The clerk will send in a check with registration forms on Friday.

Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.

Randie Johns made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Al Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.
