Discuss Mower Rental

When the hours for the two mowers that the Town rents were turned in, Pine River Leasing let us know that they are considering taking one of the mowers back because we are not putting enough hours on the tractors to justify the rent we pay. They suggested finding another town that may be interested in sharing the rent with us. We still have both mowers in the shed at this time.

Discuss IOH implementation

Final decisions for which option of the law the town chooses must be made and reported by email to the Department of Transportation by January 15, 2015. Option F seems to be the best option for the Town. In this option, the town would be choosing to do nothing, create no local ordinance, and fall under default state rules. In other words, there would be a 92,000 lbs gross vehicle weight limit on the roads. Anything over 92,000 lbs would require a no fee permit given by the Town. A final decision will be made at the January board meeting.

Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.
