Monthly Board Meeting

Those Present: Howard Hanson, Randie Johns, Allan Bartels, Teresa Hubert, Breanne Zaremba, and Dick Baumgarten.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Hanson.

The clerk's report was read. It was noted that the date for the August meeting needs to be changed to August 12, rather than August 8. Randie Johns made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The treasurer's report was read. Allan Bartels made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#### Tomah Area Ambulance

The subsidy for Tomah Area Ambulance will increase from \$5 per capita to \$7.50 per capita, which will be roughly \$3,600 per year for the Town of Tomah. Out of 16 towns represented by the service, 7 towns were represented. Howard Hanson was present and voted no for the increase for the Town of Tomah. The increase in funds will be used to purchase upgraded equipment for the ambulances.

#### Municipal Clerk Meeting

Randie Johns made a motion to allow the clerk to attend a district meeting for the Municipal Clerks Association on September 19. Al Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#### Zoning Survey

2 towns voted to change the Zoning code for Monroe County, while 9 towns voted not to change it. No actions will be taken.

The equalized value for the Town of Tomah for this year has gone down to \$123,199,200, compared to \$131,824,400 for last year.

A meeting for LRIP will be held September 18 at Club 16 in Sparta. Howard Hanson will attend.

The patrolmen have asked the board to purchase an air jack for the plow trucks and a cordless impact. Randie Johns will check prices on both.

The annual meeting for the Oakdale Area Fire Association will be held October 10, 2019 at 7:30pm at the Town of Oakdale Town Hall.

A motion was made by Randie Johns to adjourn the meeting. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.
