They currently rent out the house on the property, and would like to build a 28' x 40' shed in southeast corner of the lot. Mike Stump and Howard Randall were present because they were concerned about possible locations of the shed and water runoff, but after discussion they are fine with the proposed location. A zoning permit has been applied for, but the zoning change must occur first to change the setbacks. Randie Johns made a motion to recommend approval of the zoning change of General Agriculture to Rural Residential to the County Zoning committee. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. Motion carried.
