Special Meeting on Hockey Avenue TRIP Project

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman Hanson.

Howard Hanson contacted Jack Ditmar from the county. Mr. Ditmar said he would sign off on the engineering certification for the town if we decided to go ahead with the project, his main concern was certifying that the base of the project (base of the road) would hold up 10 years.

Al Bartels had talked to a few people who wanted the roadwork done due to accidents that have happened in the past. Howard Hanson said we could always gravel the road and save the project for a later date. Howard Hanson guessed that we would have to borrow \$20,000-\$25,000 in order to complete the project as is.
