Monthly Board Meeting

Signs for Garbage

Zingler Sign can make a sign to put up at the driveway entrance that states hours of operation for garbage and instructions. Cost of the sign will be \$467. Randie Johns made a motion to purchase the sign. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Election Grant

The Wisconsin Elections Commission is making a grant available to all municipalities that could total up to \$1200 to improve computer systems and security for elections. It would include funding for upgrades to Windows 10, IT support, and security training for election officials. Breanne Zaremba will go ahead and apply for the funding.

LRIP

Howard Hanson attended the LRIP meeting last month. Around \$140,000 is available, and 6 towns are looking into projects. Each town would receive roughly \$22,000. The Town of Tomah will not be applying because all projects would cost too much.

Compactor

The compactor needs some work, John from Modern Disposal looked at it and will provide an estimate on how much it will cost to fix. The whole unit has dropped due to wear and tear.

Employee Wage Review

Bryan Krog is currently at \$22.25/hr. Randie Johns made a motion to increase his wages to \$22.75/hr effective 10/20/19. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. Motion carried. Mark Cleaver is currently making \$18.50/hr. Randie Johns made a motion to increase his wages to \$20.00/hr effective 10/20/19. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. Motion carried. Wages for Alan Wagner will remain at \$11.50/hr. It was requested by the patrolmen to look into Retirement plans, the board is seriously considering it and will have someone present at the next meeting to explain options.

Budget Prep

The board prepared a budget for the public hearing that will be held November 11, 2019 at 7pm.
