Monthly Board Meeting

Siekert Zoning

The Monroe County Sanitation, Planning and Zoning Commission met and approved the zoning change to the Siekert property even though he was not present at their meeting. Mr. Siekert told the board that the 1 acre parcel was created in the 1970's so the parcel was probably grandfathered into current zoning. The garage is pretty much built already. Mr. Siekert's uncle is building the garage and told him that everything was okay to proceed even though he never talked to anyone, and the full County Board has not approved the zoning change yet. The Town Board technically has until January to deny the request for the zoning change, so the garage should not have been started yet.

Dale Greeno was present to let the Town Board know that he is looking for a replacement to take his seat on the Monroe County Board. He will not be filling out papers for candidacy for the April Election.

Appoint poll workers for the 2014-2015 term

Sandy Chroninger, Dale Chroninger, Susan Murphy, Leslie Brady, Julie Felts and Laura Ruland all agreed to be poll workers for the next term. Howard Hanson made a motion to approve the list of poll workers and also made a motion to give the clerk authority to assign additional poll workers over 3 for any election, as deemed necessary. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Review 2013 Bridge Inspection Report

4 bridges were inspected this past year, which were on Hiawatha Avenue, Heritage Avenue, Interior Road, and Highland Avenue. No major improvements to the bridges are needed at this time.

Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.
