Town of Tomah
Monthly Board Meeting

Those Present: Howard Hanson, Randie Johns, Allan Bartels, Richard Baumgarten, Breanne Zaremba, and Jim Bever (Town of Wilton Chairman).

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Hanson.

The clerk's report was read. Al Bartels made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The treasurer's report was read. Randie Johns made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Al Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

New Business

Jim Bever, the Chairman for the Town of Wilton, came to ask if the Town of Tomah had any plans for Juneberry Road. He has had a complaint about it being too dusty when cars drive down the road. As of right now, neither the Town of Tomah nor the Town of Wilton has any money to repair it this year.

Land Purchase from Randall Livestock

Shelley Moake gave Howard Hanson the prices that they were willing to accept for the land: 1 acre at \$10,000; 2 acres at \$16,000; and 5 acres at \$35,000. All the board members agreed that we do not need more than one acre, although \$10,000 is awfully high, especially when we will be paying for surveying, filling and permits to fill the wetlands. Randie Johns made a motion to offer \$7,500 for the one acre of land to the east of the parcel currently owned by the town. Al Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Seal Coat & Wedging Money

It looks like the costs for seal coating will be approximately \$58,300 and for wedging \$25,000. Repairs to Hiawatha from recent rains will cost approximately \$5,000.

Implements of Husbandry (IOH) Law

The state law involves oversized and overweight agricultural equipment driving on the roads. The town could require permits to drive these vehicles on the roads, but we could not charge any fees for the permits. We could also do nothing with the law. In total, the towns association presented 6 options. For now, the town will do nothing with the law.

Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.

A motion was made by Allan Bartels to adjourn the meeting. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.
