Monthly Board Meeting

New Gerke Pit

Howard Hanson attended the Public Hearing for the new pit that Gerke Excavating wishes to build in the Town of Wilton. Nobody was there to contest the project. They will now be going to Monroe County to apply for a conditional use permit.

Grapevine LRIP Project

The project was approved by the DOT on April 24, 2018. Bid notices were published in the paper on May 4 and May 11. The bid opening will be held on May 21, 2018 at 6 pm at the Town of LaGrange Town Hall. The Town of LaGrange will take the lead on the project and accept any bids on the behalf of the City of Tomah and the Town of Tomah. Separate bids for pulverizing, gravel & base, and for double chip seal will be opened that night. Winners of the bids will need to separate the work into 3 bills for each individual municipality for submittal for LRIP funds.

Harper & Joel Smith just bought property on Glasgow Ave. and wanted to bring attention to a large pothole on Goldbug Rd.

Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.
