- Howard Hanson had a few updates:
 - The Building Code Ordinance was approved by the WI DSPS, and we were sent notice on August 28, 2024.
 - Elite Electrical will be coming either this week or next week to start working on the lighting.
 - It was announced at the Ambulance Commission meeting that there would be no per capita increase for this year.
 - The Ho-Chunk Nation sent an engineering cooperative agreement so that we can be reimbursed for engineering costs for the Highland Ave Bridge up to \$60,000...projected costs are \$57,500.
