Monthly Board Meeting

Those Present: Howard Hanson, Randie Johns, Allan Bartels, Teresa Hubert, and Breanne Zaremba.

The clerk's report was read. A correction/addition was made to the information on road signs—the county will be placing all signs at county and state, the towns will be placing signs on their own roads. The treasurer's report was read. Allan Bartels made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.

WE Cares Grant

All \$1,122.90 of the grant money received by the Town has been used up to date on elections. Breanne Zaremba talked to the Wisconsin Elections Commission, and because the final report does not need to be turned in until December, they suggested submitting some of the expenses to the Roads to Recovery Act through the State, where we are able to submit for reimbursement, up to \$23,411. The next filing period for Roads to Recovery begins September 1. Breanne Zaremba will also be submitting the cost of the new ICE machine to Roads to Recovery.

Intercom

Howard Hanson has been in contact with Scott Pedretti with Alliant Energy, the Project Manager of the natural gas pipeline project. Using a combination of the formula used by ATC used to figure overweight loads from the transmission line project, and a formula used to reimburse the Town of Oakdale for the natural gas pipeline, Scott Pedretti is offering to pay the town \$26,000 above and beyond their repairs to all roads that they will be making when the project is done. Randie Johns made a motion to accept the offer of \$26,000. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. Motion carried.
