A preliminary plan was presented and discussed between all attending the meeting. Howard shared a preliminary map and ideas that have been discussed about the project. Goose and Gopher Avenues will need to be widened in order to accommodate hospital traffic. Both the City of Tomah and the Town Of Tomah stated they did not have the funds to reconstruct the roads. Money has been put into the hospital budget to reconstruct the road. Residents of the area surrounding the proposed area looked at the maps and asked questions about the preliminary plan.
