Monthly Board Meeting

Those Present: Howard Hanson, Randie Johns, Allan Bartels, Teresa Hubert, Breanne Zaremba, and Dick Baumgarten.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Hanson.

The clerk's report was read. Randie Johns made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The treasurer's report was read. Allan Bartels made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Randie Johns seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Review Assessor's Contract

The new contract from Homefield Assessing & Neil Betts for Complete Reassessment is \$33,500. The last reevaluation that we had was not a complete reevaluation, which is why it costs so much more. Tony Kiel says we have 2 years to get it done, but it was noted that the price may go up next year if we don't do it now. Al Bartels made a motion to accept the contract from Homefield Assessing to do a full reevaluation. Randie Johns seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Modern Disposal Tonnage Cost for Recycling

Modern Disposal sent out a letter stating that they would start charging \$40/ton for recycling. Their bill for tipping fees for recycling has gone up from \$10/ton to \$50/ton. The Town of Tomah has roughly 5 ton of recyclables a month, which would result in an increase of \$200 per month. This will need to be added to the budget for next year.

Non-Metallic Mining Ordinance for Monroe County

Monroe County has been working on a new ordinance for Non-Metallic Mining. Currently, the wording includes Industrial Sand and Construction Aggregate (quarries). Monroe County is asking the towns if they feel the County should continue making an ordinance just for Industrial Sand, with both Industrial Sand and Construction Aggregate, or just scrap the changes and leave everything as is. The opinion of the Town of Tomah is to leave everything the way it is. The current system works. Howard Hanson will email the County with a response for the Town. Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.

A motion was made by Randie Johns to adjourn the meeting. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.
