Public Hearing for Town Budget

The proposed budget for \$395,036.00 was presented. Teresa Hubert made a motion to send the proposed budget to the Town Board. Breanne Zaremba seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Special Town Meeting

Chairman Hanson called the meeting to order at 7:12 pm.

Authorization of use of unused Levy from 2019 to be used in 2020

There is currently \$2,006 of unused Levy from the 2019 tax year. Vaughn Kuehl made a motion to increase the 2020 Tax Levy by \$2,006. Teresa Hubert seconded the motion. Votes: 6 electors vote aye, 0 electors vote nay

Establish compensation for Elected officials

The new terms for all elected officials will begin April 20, 2021. Wages will be as follows:

- Clerk—Current compensation \$14,200/year. Randie Johns made a motion to increase compensation to \$16,000/year. Vaughn Kuehl seconded the motion. Motion carried
- Treasurer—Current compensation is \$6,000/year. Randie Johns made a motion to increase compensation to \$6,900/year. Breanne Zaremba seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Supervisors—Current compensation is \$60 per diem. Vaughn Kuehl made a motion to increase compensation to \$65 per diem. Teresa Hubert seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Chairman—Current Compensation is \$7,800/year. Randie Johns made a motion to increase compensation to \$8,400/year. Vaughn Kuehl seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Adoption of the 2020 tax levy to be paid in 2021

Allan Bartels made a motion to adopt the 2020 town tax levy to be paid in 2021 in the amount of \$229,509.26. Vaughn Kuehl seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Randie Johns made a motion to adjourn the special meeting. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.
