Non-Metallic Mining Ordinance for Monroe County

Greg Johnson from Smart Sand and Dean Yenter from Covia were present to represent the sand mines in the area. A survey was sent to the Towns to know the feelings of each zoned town regarding the proposed amendments to the Non-Metallic Mining Ordinance. The Town of Tomah is not in favor of creating an amendment to the current Monroe County Zoning Code. Conditional Use Permits currently set site specific rules and regulations. Howard Hanson will be at the next Monroe County Zoning meeting to represent the Town of Tomah. Randie Johns made a motion to vote NO to an amendment for non-metallic mining. Howard Hanson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Transportation Aid

General Transportation Aids will increase \$239/mile next year, which is roughly a 10% increase. The LRIP program has changed; it will now be LRIP 90/10, with 90% being paid by the DOT and 10% by the Town. All projects will be approved at the discretion of the DOT.
