### Update on Interior Rd Bridge Project

- There was a meeting on November 19 with the engineers, DOT, DNR, County Highway Commissioner and Chairman Howard Hanson. They Plan to have a Public Info Meeting in February or March to explain the project, what will happen, and allow for questions and answers.
- Howard Hanson presented them with a list of 40 property owners that will be affected by the road closure.
- Plans and specs are projected to be complete August 2025, Bids will be done in January 2026, and construction is set for summer of 2026.
- Current cost estimate is \$437,000, 100% will be paid by the DOT, and the engineering was paid for by the DOT already.
- The Town will be responsible for no more that \$1,000 of the cost.
