 - Fahrner Construction provided a bid with liability insurance only (no bid bond as requested in the specs)
 - For single seal, 1 mile 20' wide, with 3/8" dark granite chips, cost is \$29,250
 - Scott Construction provided a bid with liability insurance, bid bond, list of references, and list of equipment.
 - For single seal, 1 mile 20' wide, with 3/8" red granite chips, cost is \$25,794
 - For single seal, 1 mile 20' wide, with 3/8" blue granite chips, cost is \$26,757
 - For cold mix paver patch, prices vary by material used:
 - Minimum 66 ton-100-ton costs \$144/ton

- 101–300-ton costs \$121.86/ton
- 301–500-ton costs \$106.29/ton
- 501 ton and above costs \$101.31/ton
- Doug Bauman made a motion to accept all the bids provided from Scott Construction.
