#### Town of Tomah Town Board Meeting

Those present: Vauhgn Kuehl, Dick Baumgarten, Don Kaus, Ernie Thackeray, Al Bartels, Dennis Durec, Brian Hubert, Doug Bauman, Howard Hanson, Breanne Zaremba, Teresa Hubert, and Val Holmes.

Meeting was called to order at 7:02pm by Chairman Hanson.

Clerk's Report was read. Doug Bauman made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Howard Hanson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was read. Howard Hanson made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Doug Bauman seconded the report. Motion carried.

#### Public Comment Period

- Val Holmes asked when mowing will start in the Town...the patrolmen have started mowing on roads that will be getting seal coat. The DNR prefers that towns do not start mowing operations until June 15, to protect the wild lupine that the Karner Blue butterflies eat.
- Brian Hubert described the Giant Hogweed that has been seen growing along the roadways and is very irritating when touched.
- Howard Hanson updated on the Interior Rd Bridge project. Engineering costs were initially estimated to be \$75,000, but the actual contract came out to be \$83,100. The Town will be responsible for the difference. Howard has talked to the DOT and there is a change request form that can be filled out to request that the DOT pays the difference. We are waiting for the DOT in Madison to approve the contract first.

#### Southside Mobil Class A Liquor & Class A Beer Licenses

- Grewal Brothers LLC have made application to renew their Class A Liquor, Class A Beer, Cigarette, and Operator's Licenses from July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025.
- Doug Bauman made a motion to approved the above licenses for Grewal Brothers LLC beginning July 1, 2024 and ending Jue 30, 2025. Howard Hanson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

#### Estimate for LED Upgrade

- Elite Electrical Installations LLC provided 2 estimates to upgrade all lighting to LED. Option #1 for complete replacement would be \$11,590. Option #2 to retrofit the existing ballasts would be \$7,550. Doug Bauman made a motion to accept the option for \$7,550 to retrofit existing ballasts. Howard Hanson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Monthly bills were reviewed and approved.
