#### Town Road Speed Limits

Heritage Road is getting extra traffic due to the reconstruction of the County Highway M bridge. The residents feel the speed limit is too high for the road—the road is not posted so the speed limit is currently 55 MPH. There are a lot of farm machinery/slow moving vehicles traveling on the road. The county sheriff offered to put up a speed sign board to monitor traffic count and speed. The Town cannot post the road any lower than 45 MPH by law, otherwise an engineered study would need to be done. The Town will try the speed sign board to see if it helps.

#### Sealcoat Bids

- Fahrner Construction bid \$18,773.00 for 1 mile 20' wide.

Randie Johns made a motion to accept the bid for Cold Mix Wedging from Scott Construction. Allan Bartels seconded the motion. The motion carried.
