Town of Tomah Town Board Meeting

Those present: Shannon Sparks, Vaughn Kuehl, Dick Baumgarten, Doug Bauman, Tom Karacson, Breanne Zaremba, Don Kaus, Jeanette Kaus, John Ollendick, Al Bartels, Teresa Hubert, Howard Hanson, and Val Holmes.

- The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman Hanson.
- The clerk's report was read. John Ollendick made a motion to accept the clerk's report. Doug Bauman seconded the motion. Motion Carried
- The treasurer's report was read. Doug Bauman made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. John Ollendick seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Public Comment Period
  - Shannon Sparks asked on behalf of Todd – what are the buckets along Hwy 131 near Chasing Daylight for? They are there for the Amish to water their horses on hot days.
  - Howard Hanson brought up a change to the Shared Revenue program that is supposed to raise the Town of Tomah Shared Revenue from \$37,701 to \$92,696, according to their formula.
- Southside Mobil/Grewal Bros., LLC Liquor License
  - Grewal Bros, LLC has applied to renew their Class A Beer and Class A Liquor Licenses Effective July 1, 2023.
  - John Ollendick made a motion to approve renewal of the Class A Beer and Class A Liquor Licenses for Grewal Bros, LLC. Doug Bauman seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Interior Bridge Replacement
  - Howard Hanson received an official letter from the DOT stating they will pay \$89,845 for engineering costs and \$464,000 for construction costs for Bridge P-41-0180 on Interior Rd. The Town is projected to pay \$1,000 for the project.
- Snow Plow Replacement Options
  - Universal could sandblast the frame of the plow we are looking to replace. Doug Bauman suggests buying a new box for the Orange plow truck, sand blast the frame, and run the truck for 5 more years.
  - Tom Karacson suggested getting a front sander with the new box to help with traction.
  - Howard Hanson will call Universal to get more information.
  - A smaller, mid-sized truck was discussed. The truck could be purchased from Henderson International. There is no option for a wing set up for that truck, but it would accept a front and rear sander like Tom suggested.
- Motion was made by Doug Bauman to adjourn the meeting. John Ollendick seconded the motion. Motion carried.
