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Hot Tub Hire

We do have the facilities to hold and run a hot tub in the grounds of the property. If you wish to book a luxury seven-seater hot tub as an additional final touch to your stay, please inform us and we shall ensure the hot tub is up to temperature prior to your arrival. Description: Demise for life from Roger de Bradeburne knt., to John de Schavington, Chaplain, of place of arable land called le Holywalleacre in field of Bradeburne, together with all rights belonging to same in Bradeburne, paying yearly a rose on feast of St.John Baptist for all (services) and to mill corn at Bradeburne mill.

Witnesses: Richard de Bradeburne, William Frenis (?), Robert de Brokes (?), Nicholas clerk.

Date: 28 May 1330 [4 Edw.III]
