Digital Awards Guidance

The following awards serve to recognize digital or social media work produced by Oklahoma newsrooms. Eligible submissions can be posted either by a news outlet or a reporter's individual professional account. Posts made to personal/private accounts will not be considered. Submissions from any online platform are eligible for all categories.

- Outstanding short-form video
 - This award recognizes a vertical video designed specifically for social media platforms. A variety of different video styles can be considered for this award, from in the field follow-alongs to reporter standups, but submissions must be journalistic in their storytelling. Judges should consider the narration, dialogue, source quotes, cinematography and audience response in making their decisions.
- Outstanding multi-slide post (image and text)
 - This award recognizes a social media post that consists of several slides of images and text. The submission can be posted to any platform. Submissions must be journalistic in nature, such as summarizing a story or aggregating information for viewers. Judges should consider image quality, photography, graphic design, clarity, conciseness and audience response in making their decisions.
- Outstanding photo or illustration post
 - This award recognizes a post that highlights a single photo, illustration or cartoon, or one that includes multiple, but does not include text. Submissions should focus on showcasing photojournalism, editorial cartoons or other journalistic art. Judges should consider the quality of the art, the arrangement of works included, the

caption and audience response when making their decision.

- Outstanding use of online audience engagement
 - This broad award recognizes an online audience engagement initiative that is bigger than a single social media post. This could include hosting an online event or discussion, an initiative to respond to comments and report on readers' concerns, feedback forms and more. Judges should consider creativity, reach and effectiveness when making their decisions. Submissions should include a brief explanation of the initiative and its impacts.
- Outstanding email newsletter
 - This award recognizes a recurring email newsletter of any type, including those that focus on news, sports and arts, as long as it is journalistic or informative in nature. Judges should consider creativity, clarity, flow and format when making their decisions.
