Vaccine mandates are unpopular, unethical, and unconstitutional. There is no debate here- free countries do not mandate vaccinations or any other medical procedure.

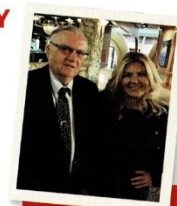
BAN CRITICAL RACE THEORY

We need free and fair elections. Mail-in voting and voting without an ID will be gone on day one.

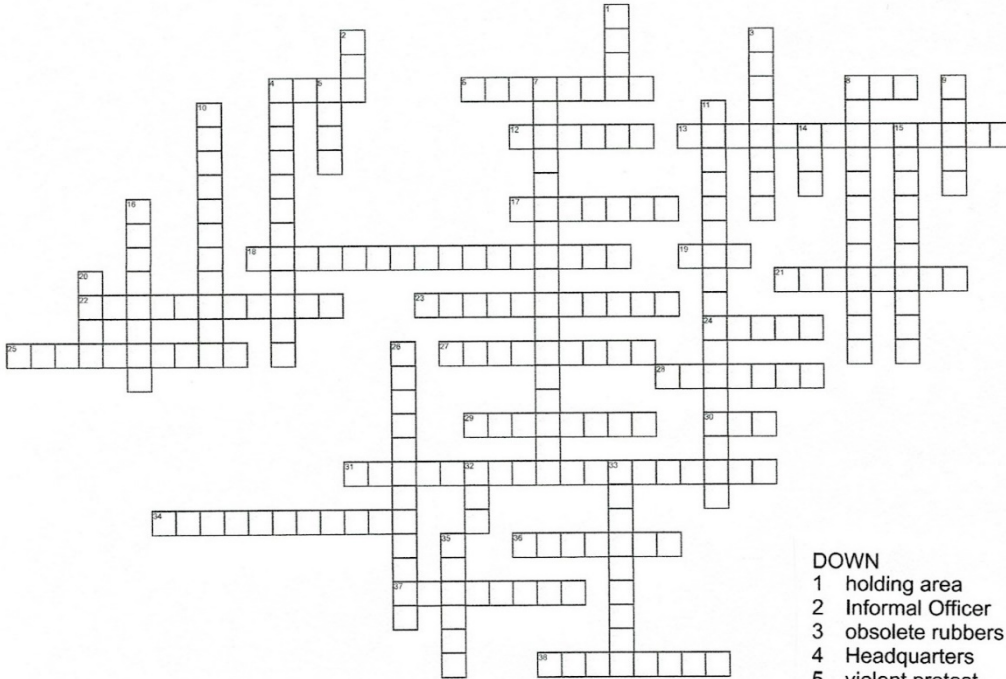
