Dr. **Heidi Morrison** is Associate Professor of History at the University of Wisconsin La Crosse. She specializes in the modern Middle East and the global history of childhood. Morrison is the author of *Childhood and Colonial Modernity in Egypt*, the editor of *Lived Resistance Against the War on Palestinian Children*, the editor of *The Global History of Childhood Reader*, and co-general editor of *A Cultural History of Youth* six-volume set. Her forthcoming book is *Inner Wounds: How Young People Remember the Second Intifada*.

Dr. **Fady Joudah** is the author of six collections of poems: *The Earth in the Attic*; *Alight*; *Textu*, *Footnotes in the Order of Disappearance*; and *Tethered to Stars*. He was a winner of the Yale Series of Younger Poets competition in 2007 and has received the Jackson Poetry Prize, a PEN award, a Banipal/Times Literary Supplement prize from the UK, the Griffin Poetry Prize, a Guggenheim Fellowship, and the Arab American Book Award.
