

1st Ever ARSU Prairie Co-op Echo Valley (Lake) Plywood Regatta

On July 15-th 2023, Amphibious Response Support Unit ONE will host the first ever Plywood Regatta (on Echo Lake) as our organization's annual fundraiser. The theme of a regatta race is a way that we can encourage safe boating practices for those who decide to recreate on our lakes.

Summary of event:

The object of this event is for competitors to build a boat with a limited amount of materials and time and have one or more member of the team race the boat around the markers to the finish line.

Competitors will be provided with 2 sheets of plywood, nails, duct-tape after attending the on-site registration and orientation session. They will also be able to use any pieces of wood found in the wood pile (supplied on site).

Using these materials competitors will build a boat, which they will enter in the race.

Teams will consist of a maximum of 4 persons and can have 1 or more paddlers.

Individuals are responsible for building their boat without assistance and the will also be the sole paddler.

Competitors are required to bring their own hand tools (hammer, saw, pliers, etc) we will allow the use of cordless saws (110 volt power is not available).

Competitors may use paint or other material to decorate, or personalize their boat including company decals, flags etc...
