QUALITY PRACTITIONER L4

The Quality Practitioner apprenticeship has been developed to support learners in a quality role and provides a highly transferable set of knowledge, skills and behaviours. Your core responsibility is to deploy effective quality practices in your responsible area to ensure the organisation fulfils the contractual and regulatory requirement of their customers and other stakeholders.

Typical duration to gateway: 12-14months

To achieve the Quality Practitioner L4 Apprenticeship Standard each learner must:

- Compile a portfolio of evidence demonstrating their competence
- Participate in regular one-to-one reviews with their line manager
- Engage with their Assessor/Tutor for guidance in meeting the required knowledge, skills, and behaviours
- Complete the minimum off-the-job training hours as set by the Department for Education
- Hold, or achieve through AM Training Associates Ltd, a Level 2 qualification in English and mathematics (mandatory for learners aged 16-18; optional for those aged 19+)
- Successfully pass the End Point Assessment

End Point Assessment (EPA)

End Point Assessment is carried out by an external organisation (EPAO) and is made up of the following:

1. Work Based Project, Presentation and Q&As - 4,000 word project based on a piece of work with a real business benefit, 35minute presentation and 25minute Q&As.
2. Professional Discussion - 60minute professional discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence.
