*WHEREAS*, as a leader, Mark is not afraid to ask the pertinent questions and firmly believes that if you don't stand for something you risk falling for anything; and


*WHEREAS*, Mark believes very strongly in the words of Edmund Burke "All that is required for the triumph of evil is for good men (people) to do nothing"; and


