Unique Introductory Facts:

- Established in 1997, and running for over 20 years, ARCT is a unique grassroots local community trust.
- ACRT is based in Akaroa, the central town for many small rural bays on Banks Peninsula. Separated from Christchurch by a large hill, Akaroa and the Bays are a one-way destination. Due to unique geography the surrounding bays can often be cut off by weather, roading, vehicle and telecommunication issues.
- •ARCT provides a safe, confidential central drop in space, and facilitates social related services in a holistic way across the community.
- Due to its small size and unique community ARCT has the capacity to organically adapt and change to meet the evolving needs of the community.
- ARCT is spiritually symbolized by an ARC or waka. A supportive structure sailing safely over the currents of life. A place of protection, but also a place to connect with others, learn effective team work and new life skills to increase quality of life.
