Filling of Planters

Filling your planters/pots this Spring with pickleballs will allow for drainage and give the roots a foundation!

They partner with businesses in Johnson County and core members weekly collect the businesses' aluminum, plastic, and paper recycling. All revenue generated from the recycling program is shared among the core members who choose this program. 

Bee There or Bee Square! Our April Showers Bring May Flowers Pickleball Mixer Has a New Date!






