

Food Insecurities ~ In 2022, The Foundation began tackling food insecurities, especially among home caregivers and their families. We are increasing our efforts in 2023, with plans to more than double the number served to 100+.



Daddy's Closet ~ In 2023, Daddy's Closet will serve 10 senior and assisted living facilities in Atlanta, Columbus, and other states across the U.S. Daddy's Closet provides hygiene, cleaning, personal care products, and other items, such as adult bibs, Ensure, bed pads, and more.



Awareness ~ In 2023, The Foundation will host its 3rd Annual Brain Health and Care Symposium. Previous community partners include churches, Mount Vernon Baptist Church, Chick-fil-A, Emory University, ALTER, and other organizations that provide information on Alzheimer's disease awareness, prevention, nutrition, elder care law, and many other topics for Caregivers, and those living with dementia.

Dental Care ~ Oral Health Day. In July 2023, in conjunction, with the Annual Brain Health and Care Symposium, The Foundation will launch the Oral Care Project. We are working with two dental offices to provide oral screenings, x-rays and cleanings for caregivers and persons living with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias.



The Dementia Care Training and Support Program will continue to support and equip caregivers with access to opportunities and resources that have not been available to underserved communities, and provide access to more intentional ways to care for persons living with Alzheimer's disease through courses, webinars, and other tools.
