

Q2: What rule has God given to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy Him?

Answer: *The Word of God, which is the Bible, is the only rule to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy Him.*

1. Key Concepts to Teach

- **The Bible is God's Word.** It teaches us who God is, what He has done, and how we should live.
- **"Only rule"** means that the Bible is our ultimate guide for truth — not traditions, opinions, or feelings.
- **"Glorify and enjoy Him"** — We learn *how* to please God and *why* we can rejoice in Him through His Word.

- *2 Timothy 3:16–17* — **"All Scripture is breathed out by God** and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness..."

2. Teaching Tips

- **Show them your Bible.** Let your child see and touch it — emphasize that this book is different because it's *from God*.
- **Explain simply:** "The Bible tells us everything we need to know about loving God and living for Him."
- **Read together regularly.** Even short, consistent readings show your child that God's Word guides daily life.
- **Model obedience.** When you make decisions, mention how you're trying to follow what the Bible says — children notice that example.

3. Questions to Discuss

- "Why do you think we need the Bible?"
- "What would happen if we didn't have God's Word?"
- "Can you name something the Bible teaches us about how to live?"
- "How does reading the Bible help us be happy in God?"

4. Activities

- **Bible Hunt:** Pick a topic (like kindness or prayer) and help your child find one verse about it.
- **Verse Memory:** Learn *Psalms 119:105* or *2 Timothy 3:16* together.
- **Draw It:** Have your child draw a picture of a lamp lighting a path (*Psalms 119:105*) to show how God's Word guides us.
- **Family "Rule Book":** Write down one short Bible verse that describes how your family wants to live (for example, *Micah 6:8* or *Colossians 3:17*).

5. Practical Application

- Teach your child to **ask, "What does the Bible say?"** when facing questions or choices.
- Show that **God's Word brings joy** — not just rules, but life and wisdom.
- Encourage your child to **start and end the day with Scripture** — even one verse or story helps plant the truth that God's Word guides every part of life.
