Qu'est-ce que c'est Quiche?

Quiche: kēSH/noun: *a baked flan or tart with a savory filling thickened with eggs.*

Quiche is considered a French dish; however, using eggs and cream in pastry was practiced in English cuisine at least as early as the 14th century and Italian cuisine at least as early as the 13th century. The word may be related to the German Kuchen meaning "cake" or "tart".
