SOLAR BIRD FEEDER Nature's beauty and light to illuminate your days and nights

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QUICK START INSTRUCTIONS

STFP 1

Turn "ON" your bird feeder -

Press the black button on the top of the solar unit

- Press button until you hear a soft click sound. If you do not hear the click, you may need to press the button more firmly.
- Verify that the unit is "ON" for charging
- To test and verify "ON" status, place your hand over the square solar panel. This solar sensor is located at the top of the bird feeder. Place your hand firmly and flat on the solar square to block all sources of light for this test. When the unit is successfully in "ON" mode and your hand is in this position, the bulb underneath solar panel (inside the column) will light up.

STFP 2

Leave the unit in "ON" mode, and charge for at least 8 hours -

Place bird feeder in an outdoor area with full and direct sun light

- Confirm the solar panel is "ON" before charging see STEP 1
- The bird feeder will only charge when in "ON" mode
- The bird feeder will automatically illuminate in the dark when in "ON" mode

STFP 3

Enjoy your solar lantern with or without bird seed -

Fill the bottom tray with seed if using as a feeder

- Place seed in bottom tray of the feeder only (Do not load seed into the center column)
- Keep the unit "ON" Then the bird feeder will automatically charge daily under direct sunlight, and will illuminate in the dark
- Enjoy the patterned light display for ambiance and glow in your outdoor and indoor spaces

MAINTENANCE AND TIPS

- Keep the solar panel clean
- Place the bird feeder away from other light sources such as street lights and garden lights. If too much light surrounds it, the unit may not turn-on automatically.
- Solar light duration depends on the level of sun light exposure and the number of hours of daylight, geographic location, clouds and other weather conditions.

BATTERY CARE AND REPLACEMENT (AA 1.2v, Ni-CD rechargeable battery)

- If storing the bird feeder for long period of time with no use, remove the battery from its compartment until ready to use
- Battery removal and replacement should be completed by an adult or under adult supervision
- If the bird feeder does not light up after active use for multiple months, replace with new rechargeable battery
- Please recycle and dispose of the battery properly (Do not place battery near source of fire nor in regular trash)
- 1) Unscrew the battery compartment cover with a Phillips head screwdriver (not included). The battery compartment is located underneath the solar panel see images below.
- 2) Open the compartment carefully to ensure welding wires inside the battery terminals are not damaged during the replacement process. Remove the used battery and install your new rechargeable battery.
- 3) Screw the battery compartment cover back into position (Check to ensure the compartment is properly sealed)





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
