Organization Committee-Allen

- 1. August financial report was presented and approved with a motion by Leslie Bosse and second by Greg Souder.
- 2. Noel Turner recommended that payroll transition from Quickbooks to Gusto and that Xero be used for accounting. Xero is a cloud based program and more user friendly than Quickbooks. Everyone agreed with Noels recommendation with a motion by Greg Souder and second by Kristyna Lewis.
