Rules for the Harrodsburg Twilight Christmas Parade

All entries must observe the following rules – THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS!

- 1. Santa will be on the fire truck at the end of the parade, so please do not ask him to be on your entry;
- LINEUP LOCATION ALL ENTRIES WILL LINEUP ON OR NEAR BROADWAY STREET. Parade participants can be dropped off at one of the following points: Broadway St/Chiles intersection by the fire station, Broadway St/Greenville or Factory St./North Main.
- 3. Make sure your group understands VEHICLES (not riding in the parade) WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARK OR ENTER THE PARADE AREA.
- Items such as candy, prizes, coupons MAY NOT BE THROWN from parade entries. However, walkers may hand out candy, prizes etc. to the spectators. (<u>We Take Safety Seriously!</u> Not adhering to this policy <u>will result</u> in a three-year ban from the parade);
- 5. Due to the impossible confusion under emergency circumstances, no sirens will be allowed from any parade entry (with the exception of official law enforcement vehicles);
- 6. Lineup will begin at 5:00 pm. All parade entries, especially vehicles such as cars and trucks are expected to be clean and in a condition appropriate for a parade;
- 7. All float entries must have a spotter (walking adult) <u>on each side</u> and must have protected wheels so that garments do not get caught if child hangs over. **This is a safety requirement;**
- 8. Vehicles in the parade can use parking lights only no headlights are permitted;
- 9. Entries must provide their own signage;
- 10. Please diaper or make arrangements to clean up after your animals (horses &/or mules).

GENERAL RULES TO CONSIDER:

- II. NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ANY ENTRY;
- 12. All floats must be driven by a licensed driver;
- 13. No one shall jump onto or off of any entry once the parade has begun;
- 14. Crowds must not be lured into the streets for any reason. There will be no crowd participation, volunteers, etc... Spectators must stay as close to the curb as possible;
- 15. REMEMBER: Any entry violating rules or behaving in an unsafe manner will be subject to immediate removal from the parade by any law enforcement office or parade worker;
- 16. Harrodsburg First Main Street Program is not responsible for accidents or injuries or any other liabilities pertaining to your entry in the Christmas Parade;
- 17. Horses, donkeys, mules etc. droppings must be cleaned off immediately. YOU ARE RESPONSBILE FOR CLEANING UP ANY EXCREMENT FROM THE LINEUP AREA;

JUDGING AND FLOAT WINNERS:

- 18. Floats will be judged on appearance, originality, and mechanics. Special lighting and the use of music are encouraged;
- 19. Judging will begin around 6:15 pm and judges will look at entries at the parade lineup. Final judging will take place during the parade and entries must complete the parade to be considered eligible;
- 20. Float winners will be announced following the parade at Olde Towne Park. First place prizes of \$100 will be announced in five float categories: civic/community, church, business/industry, school, and individual/family;
