## Timeline, Rules, FAQs and more...



### Rules/Guidelines

Check-in begins promptly at 2:00 pm at the High School. Students may park in the school lot or be dropped off. **PLEASE BE ON TIME** so we can depart for Disneyland on time and enjoy the event.

**\*\*\*THERE ARE NO REFUNDS\*\*\***

Suggested items to bring:

Student photo ID (Required)  
Empty water bottle  
Jacket/ Sweatshirt  
Wallet/\$\$  
Cell phone  
Cell phone charger.

1. DO NOT bring items such as:  
Bluetooth speakers, selfie sticks,  
glass containers and items that look like weapons. Students will not be allowed to check-in with prohibited items.
2. ABSOLUTELY NO DRUGS – All students will be screened for drugs and other prohibited items (including alcoholic beverages, smoking and vaping materials) by a drug sniffing dog at the high school and again before entering Disneyland. ONLY students with a previously completed and submitted medication form are permitted to bring any medication items and ALL medications (in a clear zip-lock bag) will be turned in to chaperones at check-in.
3. Please dress appropriately. Students that violate established SRHS and/or Disneyland dress code requirements will not be permitted to check-in. See Disneyland [Dress code policy](#).

All students are screened prior to check-in at the High School for prohibited items and proper dress.

### PLEASE BE ON TIME

Please be on time so check-in can go quickly and smoothly so we can load buses and leave.

We are highly encouraging students to be dropped off and picked up.

It will be an exhausting day and they may be too tired to drive home.

## Guest Courtesy and Dress Code Policy

- Proper attire, including shoes and shirts, must be worn at all times. Clothing that drags on the ground is prohibited in theme parks. Clothing with multiple layers is subject to search. We reserve the right to deny admission to or remove any person wearing attire that we consider inappropriate or attire that could detract from the experience of other Guests. Visible tattoos that could be considered inappropriate, such as those containing objectionable language or designs, are not permitted. There are specific costume guidelines for special events such as Halloween parties, please refer to the additional policies applicable to those events.
- Costumes may not be worn in our theme parks by Guests ages 14 or older.
- Masks may not be worn by any Guests aged 14 or older (unless required for medical purposes). When worn by younger Guests, masks must always provide unobstructed peripheral vision with openings that allow the eyes to be fully seen.
- Please show common courtesy to fellow Guests and our Cast Members not using profanity or engaging in unsafe, illegal, disruptive, or offensive behavior, jumping lines or saving places in line for others. For your safety and the safety of others, please refrain from running.
- Access to attractions depends on the safety rules for each attraction.
