Greetings,

The school year is drawing to a close, not with the usual hectic calendar of activities, but in a slightly different way. We are working hard to keep the children focused on learning, though we're making the most of the full range of opportunities we have. As I write, P3/4 are in the school garden, learning about the plants that grow there, and working in teams on an orienteering-type activity. I have seen great learning from P6 out in the local woodland, den building and carrying out a wide range of forest-school type activities.

As we mentioned last month, we are looking forward to reporting progress as we speak directly with you in the coming days, allowing you the chance to ask questions as well as hear from us about the children's learning.

We have some significant changes ahead in school. I am delighted to report that we have grown to such an extent that we will be moving from 9 to 10 classes next session. This is great news all round, and we are in the process of sorting out classes, staffing and so on. As soon as we know the situation clearly, we will be in touch with you about the classes for next session. Because of this big change, there will be some changes to composite classes and the groupings of children may differ as a result. The great news is that the change means smaller class sizes across most of the school, allowing us more time to devote to each child.

Mrs Orde will taking up a full-time role with Inspire Learning next session. I am pleased that she will continue to be based in Broomlands, allowing us to benefit from her expertise in digital technology. We will be welcoming Miss Schmidt onto our staff, working alongside Mrs Davenport in the coming year. Having worked with her previously I am sure she will be a valued member of the team here at Broomlands. We're delighted that this means Mrs Woodcock will take up a full-time class teacher position next session. We will also benefit from having two newly qualified teachers on the staff. As always, they will bring fresh ideas, new thinking and boundless energy to the school. They will be mentored by Mrs E Murray and Miss Scott. We have two remaining vacancies to which we are currently recruiting.

We held a brilliant Sports Day earlier this week – congratulations to Georgina Hancox and Martha Ashworth (girls champion and runner-up) and to Danny McMahon and Nathan Guthrie (boys champion and runner-up) on their successes. In the gruelling 'Round the Field' race congratulations to Lewis Leifer and Freddie Becattelli, Martha Ashworth and Georgina Hancox, winners and runners-up in this big race. The house this year was Broombank – very well done to them!

Water Bottles

Please do remember to send a water bottle already filled with water to school with the children in the morning.

Parking

We know that parking is a challenge in the area surrounding the school. For those with children in Primary 4-7, please do support your children to ensure they charge their iPad to at least 50% (ideally fully charged) before coming to school. It is difficult to work with children effectively when they arrive with 3% power! Thank you!
