Literacy and English



We are learning to take part in Emerging Literacy activities including:

- Phonological Awareness - beginning to recognise our names, letters and the sounds they make. We will listen to and sing phonics songs.
- Pencil Control - mark making in our play and activities, using a tripod grip to hold our pens and pencils.
- Concepts of Print - listening to stories and reading books. We will meet the Oxford Reading Tree characters and begin the discussion reading books.
- Oral Language - taking turns to talk and listen to others as we learn and play.

Social Studies



We are learning about important people in the past. We will discuss what they did and why they are famous.

We will learn about seasonal topics, and events that are important to us, including holidays/starting school, birthdays in our class, the Paralympic Games (Tokyo 2021), Roald Day and European Day. Please let us know if there is any exciting news that your child would like to share with us.

Numeracy and Maths

We are learning to

- Play number games, including dominoes, snakes and ladders and other games that use a dice.
- Count, recognise and use numbers to 10 and then beyond.
- Order numbers to 10 and then 20.
- Identify the number before, the number after and missing numbers in a sequence to 10 and then 20.
- Record our numbers, forming them correctly.



Maths:

We are learning to

- Recognise and sort 2D and 3D shapes.
- Copy, continue and create simple patterns using objects, shapes and numbers.

Look out for numbers and letters in the environment to help them begin to recognise them. Can they recognise their name from other names beginning with the same initial letter? Please try and pack their bag with them not for them, so they know what their snack is and where about in their bag it is. We will be encouraging them to pack their own bags at home time.
